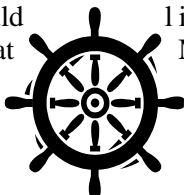


## INSTALLATION OF 2000 OFFICERS

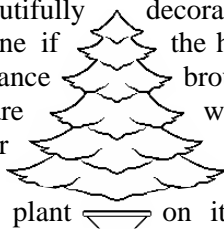
## THEME PARTY
